WHAT IS THE COST FOR THE TRAINING MANUAL? -

The instructor's professionally-bound training manual is titled: "Teach Like Great Bible Characters." The cost of the training manual is \$25.00. There are nominal charges for shipping/handling and an online processing fee. International shipping is additional. The book has an outline and illustration for each training session. Instructor and students will study this resourceful book on how to teach. There is also a section titled: The Study of Great Bible Characters. With this Student Reading Material, we first read about a Bible character and their method of teaching, then we find out how to pattern our teaching after their methods. HISTORY OF THE FORMER TRAINING PROGRAM

This training program has been revised and updated.

The former program had a short but rich history:

- This program was formerly titled: The A.S.S.I.S.S.T. program. (The acronym for: Advanced Sunday School Instruction for Sunday School Teachers.) The monthly program had a duration of approximately 5 years with over 200 churches registered. The scope of the training program has currently changed to the title: "Teach Like Great Bible Characters" and now will include and welcome not only teachers, but Christian Educators, ministers, and aspiring teachers of God's word.
- This was unique training. The Bible was used as the training manual for the seminars.
- A.S.S.I.S.S.T. program objective: whatever level a teacher might have been on, or whatever teaching abilities they might have had, the training was used to enhance their abilities. The training was not meant to restrict their individuality, but to "assist" in their development.
- The focus of the teaching was designed to place emphasis on scriptures and allow instructor-led teaching to be an example of how the scriptures alone can be taught. Emphasis was placed on: 1) studying the scriptures, 2) extracting from the scriptures, and 3) imparting scriptures into the lives of students.
