PCAF National Bible Bowl Rules

National Bible Bowl Competition will take place during the Summer National. It is open to all 16 councils and every church therein. Below are the basic rules for participation and competition.

How to participate

1. Request a copy of the PCAF - International Christian Education Auxiliary (ICEA) information packet and study guide. Send your request to:

iceaquestions@att.net

This packet has the rules and questions that will be asked at the National 2019. **(There is no need to request a copy if you got the entire online packet of all 14 pages which includes the attached questions below.)**

2. Register your teams by June 30th. This is important.

3. The age divisions are as follows: Youth ages 6-12, Teen 13-17 and Adult 18 and up.
4. There is a registration fee of \$50.00 per team competing on the national level.
5. Prizes will be awarded to the first and second place teams.

Game Rules

1. All teams should be gathered in announced room on time and prepared to play.
2. The questions for competition will consist of multiple choice, true or false, fill in the blank, specific answer, quotation completion and direct quote.
3. Questions should be answered exactly as they are worded in the study guide (*which have been researched or referenced by chapter and verse(s) in Genesis*).
4. Each round will consist of twenty questions plus bonus questions if needed.
5. Each game should be provided with a scorekeeper, timer, quizmaster and two (2) judges.
6. During play, there will be no hints or clues from the audience -- only silence.
7. Each question is worth ten (10) points. If the same team answers three (3) questions in a row, they will be given a bonus question.
8. During play, the first person that buzzes in is the only one allowed to answer for the team.
9. If a team thinks that a question from the other team was answered incorrectly, they may contest by getting the attention of their coach. (There will be no outburst or talking out loud from any team member.) Their coach will then call for a "contest." This is where the judges make a ruling on whether the question is correct or incorrect.
10. The game will play as a run-off with elimination rounds. If a team wins against their opponent, they stay in the game for the next round while the losing team is eliminated.
11. There are two (2) time-outs available to each team. Only the coaches can call for a time out.
